

Formal Wear Competition



This is a required competition and is 30% of each State Finalist's total score.

Attire Rules

Princess/Jr Pre-Teen/Pre-Teen

- A formal dress that is appropriate for your age and personality
- Your dress may be any length and any style
- No bare midriffs
- Shoes should be flats or small heels that complement your dress.
- No noticeable makeup

Jr Teen/Teen/Miss

- A prom or formal dress that is appropriate for your age and personality
- Your dress may be any length or style
- Shoes should complement your dress and you should be able to walk smoothly, confidently and safely in them
- Makeup must be age appropriate

Escorts

You will need an escort for the Formal Wear Competition, except for Miss contestants who do not have escorts.

Escorts may be a father, mother, brother, cousin, grandfather, aunt, uncle, or any family member or friend.

Escorts may wear suits, tuxedos, military uniforms, or "Sunday Best".

Escorts are only needed during the Formal Wear Competition, not during the Final Show. During the Final Show, the State Finalist is presented on stage alone. Your escort is welcome to attend the Final Show as an audience member and would need a ticket.

Basics

You will be introduced by the emcee as you are escorted onto the stage by your escort in the formal dress of your choosing. Miss contestants do not have escorts.

There is no admission charge for audience members to attend the Formal Wear Competition.

During Pageant Weekend, each State Finalist will attend a rehearsal to practice walking with her escort. No escorts for Miss age division.

Escorts are encouraged to attend this rehearsal, but it is not required.
