## Basics

This is a closed competition without an audience.

You will bring your resume with you. This is a form that you will be provided a few weeks before the pageant to complete and bring with you Pageant Weekend.

You will chat one-on-one with each interview judge. The questions asked will not have right or wrong answers. The judges just want to get to know you and will ask about your personal experiences.

You will wear a professional outfit of your choosing. No noticeable makeup for Princess, Jr Pre-Teen, and Pre-Teen. Age-appropriate makeup allowed for Jr Teen, Teen and Miss.

## Tips

- The judges want to get to know you so be sure to let your personality shine through as you chat with each one.
- Maintain eye contact with the judges and sit forward in your chair with good posture.
- Answer each question in complete sentences.
- You are interviewing for the job of State Queen and this is the perfect time to allow the judges to see your enthusiasm for representing your state and National American Miss.

- You will wear the same outfit for the Personal Introduction and the Interview Competitions.
- Pick an outfit you would wear to a professional job interview. This can be a dress, suit, or coordinated pants outfit. Choose something that you enjoy wearing and helps you feel confident.
- No hats, gloves, purses, props or gadgets allowed.
- Choose age-appropriate shoes that complement your outfit
- Age-appropriate Jewelry may be worn for all age groups.
