

CORRECTION TEXT

*'...on 01.06.2024, on the website https://www.odatv.com/guncel/ukrayna-savasina-bir-de-boyle-bakin-zelenski-kumar-oynuyor-ama-gercek-anlamda-120046636#google_vignette with the extension **Ukrayna Savaşı'na bir de böyle bakın... Zelenski kumar oynuyor... Ama gerçek anlamda**" is baseless, untrue and a direct attack on our Company's commercial reputation and personal rights. While the news article was being made, our Company, its officials, Director and/or lawyers were not contacted in any way, their information and opinions were not consulted, and no right of reply was granted. For this reason, we hereby retract the entire news report.*

Our Company operates as Vuni Palace Hotel & Casino in Kyrenia, TRNC, where it holds the license to operate a hotel and games of chance hall. As a business that is subject to strict supervision due to its field of activity, it fulfills all the conditions related to the operating license in accordance with the TRNC legislation. Both the hotel and the gambling halls have been operating for many years with operating licenses and legal permits.

*On the other hand, it is important to note that, pursuant to the TRNC Chapter 113 Companies Law and the detailed legislation No. 31/2009 on Gaming Halls, the transfer of shares in the existing shareholding structure and/or the sale/transfer of shares to a foreign real or legal person is subject to the approval and detailed supervision of the TRNC Council of Ministers. **For our Company, there is no share transfer or business transfer under any circumstances.***

In addition, the website with the extension <https://casinohotelvunipalace.com/>, where the name of the company with the title "Film Heritage Inc." is mentioned in the news article, is a fake website that has nothing to do with the official website of our hotel and where images whose copyright belongs to our Company are used unauthorized and illegally. Further legal action will be taken in this regard. My hotel operates through the official website <https://www.vunipalacehotel.com/> and there is no other website other than this.

The statement in the same news article; "According to Booking.com, Vuni Palace has not been taking reservations since May 27, possibly due to the ownership change process." does not reflect the truth in any way. As it is known, Booking.com website cannot be booked through Turkey due to the restriction by the authorities in Turkey and this issue has been on the agenda for days in the media; it is a well-known information by everyone. Our hotel continues to receive international reservations legally through Booking.com.

As explained; baseless allegations that aim to damage the commercial reputation of our Company should not be trusted. The news is completely unfounded and untrue, and it is respectfully announced to the public for information purposes that such news should not be trusted..."
